

DRESS CODE:

All students must wear a FULL uniform to and from school each day and present a clean and neat appearance. Students who are out of uniform may receive silent lunch. **Repeat offenders will receive a disciplinary notice, detention and possibly, Saturday school. The school reserves the right to ask the student to remove any clothing or jewelry deemed in violation.**

BOYS:

Navy blue dress pants must be worn. No jeans or pants with pockets attached outside. Pants must fit properly and not be oversized. **Faded or torn pants must be replaced.** A solid black, brown, or Navy blue belt must be worn at all times and must be visible. Navy blue shorts are a warm weather option (August/September/October and April/May). Shorts must be above the kneecap. They must be worn with a belt and may not be cut off pants. Pants and shorts are worn with the waistband at the waist above the hipbone. Boys must wear pants from November 1st through March 31st.

Shirts are short sleeve white knit or long sleeve white knit shirts with no emblems. Shirts are to be tucked in at all times with the waist band and belt clearly visible. **Undershirts must be plain white.** P.E. shirts may not be worn as undershirts.

Sweaters are navy blue V-neck or the new gray sweatshirts with SHS logo and must BE PURCHASED FROM FONTAINE APPAREL. Students wearing frayed or torn sweaters/sweatshirts will be required to remove them. The navy blue sweater may be worn until the end of this school year 09-10. Jackets may be worn on cold days, but the school sweater or gray sweatshirt with SHS logo must be worn underneath.

Shoes must be school dress shoes. Shoes should be black or brown, no boots or shoes above the ankle. No sneakers of any type or backless shoes.

Socks must be white, black or navy blue crew socks with no markings or insignia. Crew socks must be above the ankle. Low cut socks are prohibited.

Hair must be well groomed. No fad hair styles will be allowed. Hair must not hang over the collar or over the eyebrows or touch the ears. Hair may not be bleached, highlighted or dyed. Boys who have their hair partially shaved will be asked to have it completely shaved until it grows back at even lengths. No excessive gelling or spiked hair styles are allowed. Hair depth for the scalp shall not exceed $\frac{3}{4}$ inch.

No jewelry is permitted except small (less than 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches) religious necklaces and watches. All uniforms, P.E. clothes, etc. shall be marked with student's name.

GIRLS:

Jumpers for grades K - 4 and skirts for grades 5-8 must be purchased from Fontaine Apparel. **Skirt length** should be appropriate, **no more than 3 inches above the knee measured while the student is kneeling.** Shorts must be worn under the jumper/skirts. Parents please keep in mind that students grow taller during the school year. Purchasing items that just meet length requirements at the start of the school year will likely require early replacement.

The new shirts are short sleeve white knit or long sleeve white knit shirts with no emblems. The white button front, short sleeve blouses may be worn until the end of this school year 09-10. Shirts should be neatly tucked in at all times so that the skirt waistband is visible. Only white or flesh tone undergarments should be worn. The uniform skirt may not be altered and must be worn with waistband at the waist above the hipbone.

Red cardigan sweaters for grades K-6 and red pullover sweaters for 7-8 graders or the new gray sweatshirts with SHS logo must be purchased from Fontaine Apparel. Students wearing a frayed or torn sweater/sweatshirt will be required to remove them. The red sweaters may be worn until the end of this school year 09-10. Jackets may be worn in cold weather, but the school sweater/gray SHS sweatshirt must be worn underneath.

Shoes shall be dress style, solid black or dark brown. No sandal type, boots, sneakers, shoes above the ankle or backless shoes are allowed. Heels of shoes cannot exceed 1" in height.

Girls have an option of wearing white crew socks, red knee socks (purchased through FONTAINE) with no insignia or other markings, or black tights. Crew socks must be above the ankles. Low cut socks are prohibited. Panty hose are prohibited. No socks are to be worn over tights.

Girls are not permitted to wear nail polish, fake nails, make-up, or jewelry. Girls may wear one pair of small stud type earring in the lower ear lobe. No dangling earrings. Religious chains with cross medal (no medallions) no larger than an inch and a half may be worn. Rings, bracelets or other necklaces are NOT allowed. These will be confiscated and returned at the end of the day. Hair must be clean, combed or braided. Hair may not be streaked or colored. Hair scarves are not allowed. All uniforms, P.E. clothes, etc. shall be marked with student's name.

COLD WEATHER POLICY:

When the weather is forecast to be colder than 35 degrees (F) students will be directed to wear their PE sweat suit (pants *and* shirt). Long sleeve shirts are not to be worn under the P.E. tee shirt. The long sleeved knit school shirt may be worn in place of the P. E. shirt. Coats should be worn over the P.E. sweats.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM:

P.E. uniforms should be brought to school in a separate P.E. bag and all clothing must be marked with the student's name.

P.E. uniforms can be purchased on book day, at the gym after the school year has started (hours/days are posted in the gym), or by completing an order form and leaving it in the office.

P.E. shirts are to be plain white or Sacred Heart issued white, grey, or red. The shirt must be loose fitting and is worn tucked inside the waist. T-shirts from Sacred Heart school activities are allowed at the discretion of the administration (Rec ball, First communion t-shirts, etc). They must have SHS or Sacred Heart School in their logo/design.

Shorts shall be red Sacred Heart issued only. Shorts must be loose fitting and long enough to reach the student's fingertips when the student's arms are held straight down their side. The waist band shall be worn at the waist. No sagging or low riding shorts allowed.

White crew length socks only. No ankle, quarter or low cut socks. Athletic shoes shall have non-skid soles.

Sweatshirts and sweatpants will be red. No logos or writing is allowed except for Sacred Heart School issued sweats. Sweats are required for all classes between November 1 and March 1.

Long sleeve shirts are not to be worn under P.E. shirts. Shorts and t-shirts are always worn beneath sweats. Boys' shorts must be pulled up over the waistband of underwear. Boxer style shorts must not extend out from the bottom of the shorts. Girls undergarments must be worn beneath P.E. shirts and must be white (Flesh tones are also acceptable).

FREE DRESS DAYS:

Students must wear clothing appropriate to a Catholic school. Clothing should fit correctly. Logos (excluding brand names i.e. Old Navy), slogans, cartoons, etc... should not be worn. Frayed or torn clothing will not be permitted. All students must wear socks (visible) and shoes.

Shoes may be sneakers or must meet normal uniform standards (can be other colors). No sandals, flip flops, crocs, boots, backless, etc... permitted. No tank tops, spaghetti straps or strapless tops may be worn—even with a cover-up.

Jewelry must meet normal uniform standard.

When in doubt—DON'T WEAR it.
